Mares

- *ORIGINAL* registration papers AND one photocopy.
- Official 4-generation pedigree from the registry that issued the mare's original registration papers AND one photocopy. You can obtain pedigrees for JC mares from the Jockey Club.
- Proof of current negative Coggins test. Also current Health Certificate if required by your state or any states you may be traveling through to reach the inspection site (check with your veterinarian regarding requirements.)

Foals/Yearlings

- *ORIGINAL* Breeding Certificate signed by the stallion owner. To prevent dual registration of foals, photocopies of the Breeding Certificate will not be accepted.
- Proof of current negative Coggins test and current Health Certificate if required by your state or any states you may be traveling through to reach the inspection site (check with your veterinarian regarding requirements).
- If the foal's dam has already been inspected and approved by this registry, bring a copy of her original registration papers showing her mare approval stamp AND/OR a copy of her mare inspection report.
